

PARKING & DROP OFFS:

Please read carefully

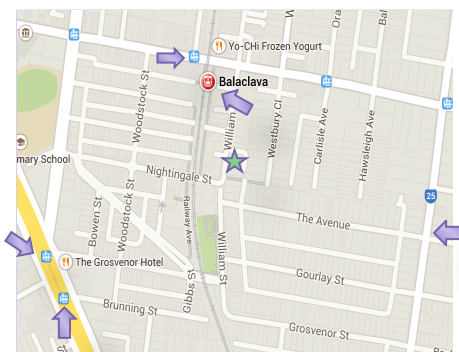
I cannot stress the importance of this enough. Please **ONLY** park in public street parking. Under no circumstances are you to park in the Rishon parking, across driveways or in any other buildings car parks. No 'I'll just be a few seconds' parking either.

If you do need to park to drop off or pick up, your safest bet will be to enter William St from the other side. There is ample parking on either side of the road and you just have to walk up to the studio - we are right near the dead end.

The purple lines on the map indicate where parking is available.

For drop offs please make sure that you are not blocking traffic etc and that students are not crossing the road near the bend.

Take a few minutes to map out the best way to get to us - a tip is to avoid Carlisle St if you can.



Public Transport

We are very easily accessible via public transport too! Very handy for those of you coming straight from school!

Trams that run along

Carlisle St: 3, 3a, 16 to stop at Carlisle St/Nelson St

Brighton Rd: 67, 68 to stop at Brighton Rd/Chapel St or Brunning St.

Buses that run along Hotham St are: 219 & 216 to stop at The Ave/Hotham or Melby Ave/Hotham

We also have **Balaclava Train Station** right next door!
